Heartworm



Dogs get heartworms from infected mosquitos that bite them. The mosquito gets infected by biting a dog that is infected with heartworms. Microfilariae develops into infective larvae within the mosquito and then when the mosquito bites, the infected larvae then enters the new dog. The larvae then migrates to the dog's right side of the heart where they develop into adult heartworms.



Protect your dog's heart, prevention is cheaper than treatment!!
